Thuy Bowyer

Thuy Bowyer grew up in the affluent home of a Vietnamese military family. At the age of 12, she and her family fled her country two days before the fall of Saigon. She arrived in America with nothing but a pair of pajamas. An aunt helped the family make the transition – even making Bowyer answer the phone as a way to learn English.

She learned the importance of caring for family. So when her mother was in pain, Bowyer reached out to her. In the process of caring for her mother, this problem solver learned not only the techniques of massage that helped her mother live without chronic pain, but she also discovered the incomparable reward of helping others.

As owner of M.T. Wellness Clinic for the past ten years, Bowyer is a pioneer in the field of Medical Restorative Massage Therapy (MRMT) – a practice that fills the gap between Traditional Massage and Physical Therapy. She has devoted hundreds of hours to advanced training, and leads a dedicated team of five women, working to help patients reduce pain and restore physical function.

As a business owner, Bowyer understands the need for women to learn from each other and to support one another in their careers. She also understands the need for women to encourage each other to make decisions based on facts – not emotion.

Her hope for her patients flows from Bowyer's four key values: awareness, wholeness, vitality, and serenity. She believes the mind and the body are connected and attributes her success to starting each day with gratitude.

Her focused and disciplined approach to planning helped her take her venture from a side hobby of helping friends and family to a thriving business. Even though she didn't have a budget for advertising or marketing, the quality of her work and successful business practices led her to win the Visionary Award from the Columbus Chapter of the National Association of Women Business Owners in 2005.

Bowyer is a determined woman who works hard remaining persistent in believing that teamwork and gratitude bring out the best in herself, in her family, in her employees, and especially, in her patients.
